If this student participates in the RHS-PIB / IB program at RHS on a Special Pupil Assignment (SPA) attendance waiver from the CCSB, we understand that that document may be renewed annually.

We understand that if at such time this student chooses to leave or is removed from the RHS-PIB/IB Diploma Program, any SPA attendance waiver may be revoked and the student may be reassigned to the zoned school.
